



Chalutzim or Pioneers, come together to learn about the value of *Tikkun Olam, Repairing the World*, in a fun and engaging setting. This program is designed to transition our campers from Alumim, and start learning about this important value. Chanichim can expect to get a better understanding of what a social justice cause is, and start their leadership development.

WHAT IS CHALUTZIM?

Chalutzim is our next program after Alumim. This is a collection of participants in grades 6 and 7 in Montreal and Toronto. The goal of this program is to engage our intermediate campers, and start building on the core values of our movement through a higher level of programming.

WHAT KINDS OF PROGRAMS DO WE DO?

Throughout the year, our programs will be focused around what the concept of Tikkun Olam is, and why being a compassionate member of our community is so important. Programs will explore leadership in an experiential way, and how to be a leader for causes that are important to our members.

WHY SHOULD MY CHILD PARTICIPATE?

Your child should participate in these programs because it keeps the spirit of camp alive throughout the year. It is a great way to expand your involvement in CYJ, and for your camper to develop friendships outside of their camp. They are also fun, and a great way to spend an afternoon once a month. As it is the next step in the CYJ journey, your campers are going to get more in depth knowledge, and will gain confidence in all aspects of their lives.

HOW WILL PROGRAMS WORK DURING THE PANDEMIC?

We follow the advice of our Medical Consul for all of our programs. We will do in person programs, where permissible, based on all necessary guidelines as set out by the local health authority. There will be a mix of in person and online programs to keep our chanichim engaged.
